## REQUIREMENTS FOR A DIPLOMA FROM RAY OF HOPE ACADEMY

Additional periodicals, charts and books may be required.

- Small class size (minimum of two to maximum of six students) for individualized educational attention.
- Successfully pass exams throughout the book. There will be a final exam at the end of the course of textbook study.
- Attendance at **all** classes and activities as required.
- Student interaction and participation is vital for the learning and evaluation processes.
- Additional Anatomy & Physiology is included and required as part of this course of study starting
   2018 for all students no matter what the student's past learning experience has been.
- All students must carry Student Insurance for the full term of study prior to practicum on people.
   A copy must be on file with Ray of Hope Academy. Ray of Hope Academy must be an additional insured.
- CPR & AED Certification. If you are currently certified, please present a copy of your card to Lila and no need to repeat the class until your card expires.

- If you miss a class due to illness or other vital absentee requirement(s), you must make up the time with Lila Mueller.
- 75 documented practicum volunteers are required. Free Open Teaching Clinic participants at Ray of Hope Academy will count towards this requirement.
- Full payment of all fees to Ray of Hope Educational Services d/b/a Ray of Hope Academy is required before receiving a Diploma.
- Upon successful completion of the course of study, the student will be awarded a Silver Diploma.

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

**Reflexology** is a stand-alone profession, and is **NOT** massage.

Live Core Curriculum Class Tuition is \$6,000.00. A Payment Plan is available. All Payment Plan Fees are due on the first of the month. An additional Book Fee is required at registration. Auxiliary Classes are at an additional cost.

A **minimum** of 200-300 hours of instructor-student contact hours will take place. 180 live contact hours are required by the American Reflexology Association which Ray of Hope Academy exceeds in live classes.

- Your Book Fee covers books and supplies needed for this course of study and will be passed out to students. Do not privately purchase these materials as the **Book Fee is not refundable**.
- Students bring note paper, highlighters, binders, etc. to enhance your learning style.
- Attendance is vital to learning and having interaction with instructors and fellow students.
  Please be in attendance and prompt by 8:30 a.m. on Saturdays and 1 p.m. on Sundays.
- Instructional dress will be Professional Casual
- Teaching will be done in ways that everyone will participate with different methods so everyone will learn.
- A pot luck will take place on Saturdays. Snacks will be provided on Sundays.
- Complimentary coffee, tea and water will be available throughout the day for students.
- Student Membership Fee will be paid for by Ray of Hope Academy for a 1 year period to our state Reflexology organization (Integrated Reflexologists of Wisconsin, Inc.) after 6 months of class attendance.
- Tutoring is available outside of class time at an additional fee.
- Auxiliary Classes, although not required, are at an additional expense.
- The 2025 Ray of Hope Academy Teaching Schedule will be adhered to once decided upon at the first class for students and reevaluated each quarter. We will avoid holidays.
- Cancellation of classes will be made by email and/or telephone call to students. In cases of bad weather, students will participate via virtual classes.
