How does Ray of Hope Academy differ from other Reflexology schools?

- Ray of Hope Educational Services, LLC, d/b/a Ray of Hope Academy, is considered a niche vocational school. The instruction is intense on anatomy & physiology, techniques, problem solving, business skills. The program is intense and at college level with over 400 contact hours in duration. Class size is limited for maximum instruction.
- The public is invited in for a Free Open Clinic whereby the student performs Reflexology on the volunteer, documents them and is observed by the instructor for technique refinement.
- Observation of body structure is stressed with attendance at a Flag Day Parade so students can observe military personnel, parade participants and the general crowd for possible health issues.
- Students are taught on how to question, the question. Intense intake is instructed so that the Reflexology student is able to connect the systems to make an analytical treatment plan.
- Incorporation of the missing link - Traditional Chinese Medicine. TCM is vital to evaluate reflexes and the overall condition of the body and where energy is in excess or deficient. Introduction of TCM is a required prerequisite class.
- A two day Business Class is included which features a panel of experts in the fields of law, accounting, health insurance, property and liability insurance as well as a successful business person. Business Plan development will take place in this class.
- Several books are required reading.
- Building a hand and foot out of clay is a required project.
- An Anatomy & Physiology Coloring Book is required to be completed. All eleven body systems will be taught.
- Each student is assigned several conditions that they need to research and write a paper explaining on how Reflexology will help the conditions and explain their techniques.
